ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

A bachelor's degree in another discipline, or equivalent practical, professional or educational experience of an appropriate kind.

If English is your second language, a minimum IELTS (Academic) score of 6 with no band score lower than 5.5 or equivalent, is required.

You will also be required to submit a portfolio of creative work and attend an interview as part of the enrolment process. You are encouraged to bring whanau or other support people to this interview to support your application. You will be required to have a high level of computer literacy in your given field of expertise.

The programme will prepare you for career opportunities across a wide spectrum of the Creative Technology industries. You will also have the appropriate skills and knowledge to pursue further study and professional development opportunities.
