2010 APPLICATION GUIDE

Purpose

WelTec is offering 80 Youth Guarantee places for students who meet the Youth Guarantee (YG) criteria and who wish to study a Youth Guarantee eligible course at WelTec. YG students do not pay any fees for their study.

Applicants must meet the eligibility criteria for their desired programme and complete an enrolment form as well as an application.

WHO CAN APPLY

Applicants must:

- Be 16 or 17 years of age and not turn 18 within 3 months prior to the commencement of their course (DOB 1/6/92 or later);
- Be a new student to tertiary study (STAR courses excluded);
- Have completed year 11 and have not gained a NCEA Level 2 qualification;
- Agree to the conditions of being a YG student
- Be a New Zealand citizen or have New Zealand permanent residency;
- Enrol in a full-time programme of study, starting Trimester 1, 2010 in a nominated YG course
- Meet the entry requirements and be accepted onto one of the eligible WelTec YG courses;

Selection Criteria

The criteria of selection will be based on:

- Demonstration of a genuine desire to succeed in their chosen field of study and aspirations for employment once qualified
- Demonstration of aptitude for the selected programme
- WelTec will select students whose course choices best match the availability in the programmes

Selection Process

- Submit a completed application form and enrolment form to WelTec .
- Applicants may be required to attend an interview and to have a Personal Education Plan (PEP). The Pep takes an hour. Applicants will be contacted for an appointment.
- Applicants will be notified on the status of their application by WelTec in due course .

Conditions

- YG students are exempt from student fees for only one year.
- Students are not eligible for loans of any kind from Studylink.
- Applicants must be willing to have their progress monitored and take part in a programme of Learning Support.
